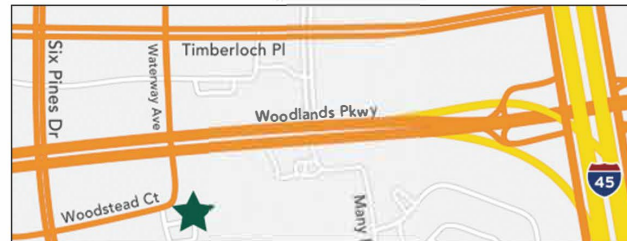

WHAT IS LOW VISION?

Low vision refers to a vision impairment that is not correctable with standard eyeglasses, contact lenses or through use of surgery or medication.

WHAT IS LOW VISION CARE?

Low vision care is the evaluation and management of a low vision patient by an eye care and vision rehabilitation professional. Based on an individual assessment with specialized testing, aids and services will be discussed to overcome the lifestyle impact of the vision impairment.
